FLORIDA AMENDMENTS

Amendment 1 **VOTE YES**

Limitation on the Assessment of Real Property Used for Residential Purposes

A YES vote on this amendment: Authorizes the Florida State Legislature to pass laws prohibiting flood resistance improvements to residential property from being considered when determining that residential property's assessed value for property taxes.

Amendment 2 **VOTE YES**

Abolishing the Constitution Revision Commission

A YES vote on this amendment: Supports abolishing the Florida Constitution Revision Commission (CRC). The CRC meets every 20 years to propose changes to the state's constitution and refer them to the statewide ballot for voter approval or rejection.

Amendment 3 **VOTE YES**

Additional Homestead Property Tax Exemption for Specified Critical Public Services Workforce

A YES vote on this amendment means the voter supports authorizing the legislature to grant an additional homestead exemption (up to \$50,000) for homestead property owned by teachers, law enforcement & correctional officers, firefighters, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, child welfare professionals, active duty members of the US Armed Forces, and The Florida National Guard. Unlike Amend. 1, the 2022 legislature passed a bill (HB 1563) to implement this amend., if approved. Governor DeSantis signed the bill, so approval of Amend. 3 enacts this new exemption.

County Question 1

VOTE: AGAINST BONDS

Increase workforce and affordable housing units to address rising housing costs general obligation bonds.

County Question 2

VOTE: NO

Referendum to continue ad valorem levy for school safety, teachers, and operational needs.
